

Modern Slavery & Human Trafficking Statement

Zireto Winnie Ris Limited (trading as StackwiseSoft) — Financial year 2025/2026

Introduction

This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the UK Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes the modern slavery and human trafficking statement of Zireto Winnie Ris Limited (Company No. 16969923), trading as StackwiseSoft ("the Company"), for the financial year ending 2026. The Company has a zero-tolerance approach to modern slavery, forced labour, servitude and human trafficking in all forms, whether within our own operations or across our supply chain.

Our organisation

StackwiseSoft is a UK-registered software company that develops browser-based productivity software, including AI writing tools, PDF conversion utilities, CRM, notes and project collaboration modules. The Company is headquartered at 19 Irvine Street, Leigh, England, WN7 1ND, United Kingdom, and operates a small remote workforce supported by a limited number of professional service providers and cloud infrastructure vendors.

Our supply chain

Because we deliver a fully digital service, our supply chain is short and predominantly low-risk. It consists primarily of cloud hosting providers, payment processors, professional services (legal, accounting), SaaS tooling used to run the business, and freelance contractors engaged for design, engineering and content work. All key vendors are established businesses based in the UK, EU, or United States.

Policies

We maintain internal policies that reinforce our commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in all business relationships. These include our Acceptable Use Policy, Code of Conduct, Whistleblowing procedure, Recruitment and Equal Opportunities policy, and Supplier Due Diligence guidelines. All staff and contractors are required to acknowledge these policies at onboarding.

Due diligence and risk assessment

We assess modern slavery risk when engaging new suppliers and contractors. Higher-risk relationships are subject to additional review, including confirmation of legal entity status, right-to-work documentation for individual contractors, and — where relevant — a written commitment that the supplier complies with the UK Modern Slavery Act 2015 or equivalent local legislation. We do not knowingly engage suppliers who have been found to be in breach of anti-slavery legislation.

Training and awareness

All employees and long-term contractors receive guidance on identifying and reporting concerns relating to modern slavery, human trafficking, or exploitative labour practices. Concerns can be raised confidentially to the Director at director@stackswissoft.com or through our whistleblowing

channel without fear of retaliation.

Effectiveness

The Company has received no reports, allegations or findings of modern slavery within its operations or supply chain during the reporting period. We review this statement annually and update our policies, supplier onboarding, and training as our operations evolve.
